

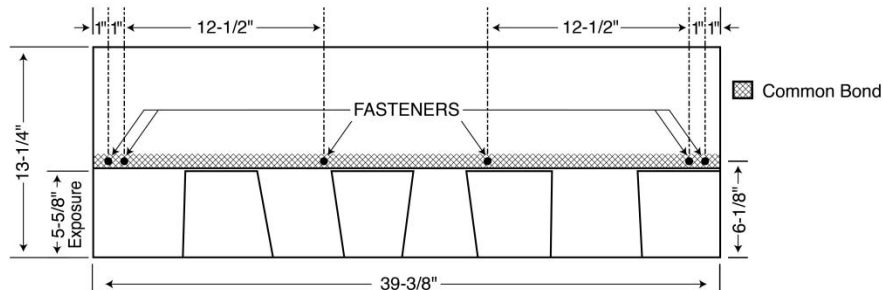


**ALTERNATIVE HIGH WIND APPLICATION LIMITED WARRANTY FASTENING PATTERN FOR LAMINATED FIBERGLASS/ASPHALT SHINGLES MANUFACTURED AT DALLAS, TX; FREDERICK, MD; JOPLIN, MO; PHILLIPSBURG, KS; AND TUSCALOOSA, AL\***

The fastening pattern illustrated below is an acceptable alternative to the fastening pattern described in the High Wind Warranty Fastening Pattern section of the application instructions identified below for installation of TAMKO Heritage®, Heritage® IR, and Heritage® Premium Laminated Asphalt Shingles manufactured at the production locations identified below. All other requirements of the High Wind Warranty Fastening Pattern section must be followed to qualify for the High Wind Application Limited Warranty.
